1. If the yang meridians were needled on the right arm and yin meridians were needled on the left arm, what meridians would be needled on the left and right legs in order to preserve the Global Balance?
2. If adding Yao Tong 5 into a 12 Magical treatment for low back pain on the right side, which hand would you designate for Yao Tong 5?
3. Write a point prescription that follows the basic rules of Dr Tan's Strategy of 12 Magical Points.
4. Why are Jing Well points on the hand yin channels preferred when treating any type of headache?
5. When the elbow region is needled on the yang surface of the left arm and the lower leg is needled on the yin surface of the left leg, where are the needles likely to be placed on the remaining two limbs in a treatment according Dr Tan's Strategy of 12 Magical Points?
6. What is the maximum number of meridians needled on each limb in Dr Tan's Strategy of 12 Magical Points?
7. If the right foot is yang Jing Well Points and the left foot is yin Shu Stream Points, what are the remaining arrangement of points on the upper limbs?
8. When the elbow region is needled on the yin surface of the left arm and the lower leg is needled on the yang surface of the left leg, where are the needles likely to be placed on the remaining two limbs in a treatment according Dr Tan's Strategy of 12 Magical Points?
9. When the fingers are needled on the yang surface of the left hand and the wrist is needled on the yin surface of the right hand, where are the needles likely to be placed on the remaining two limbs in a treatment according Dr Tan's Strategy of 12 Magical Points?
10. If the right foot is yin Jing Well Points and the left foot is yang Shu Stream Points, what are the remaining arrangement of points on the upper limbs?
