

## Distance Acupuncture Post-Course Evaluation Questions – Short Answer

1. If the patient's Day Master is a Water element, what channels will you use in a Global Balance?
2. If the patient's Day Master is a Fire element, what channels will you use in a Global Balance?
3. If the patient's Day Master is a Wood element, what channels will you use in a Global Balance?
4. If the patient's Day Master is a Metal element, what channels will you use in a Global Balance?
5. If the patient's Day Master is a Earth element, what channels will you use in a Global Balance?
6. Is it important that your patient knows you are about to begin the treatment?
7. Should you do needle manipulations on the AcuModel?
8. Case Study: Female Patient, Date of Birth = July 21, 1989. Chief Complaint – Left sided neck pain at the occiput and left sided shoulder pain between the scapula and thoracic spine. Please determine her Day Master, her appropriate Global Balance Pattern, and list the acupuncture points that you would select to treat on the Acupuncture Model.
9. Case Study: Male Patient, Date of Birth = January 18, 1942. Chief Complaint – right sided low back pain radiating down the back of the right leg to the posterior aspect of the right knee. Please determine his Day Master, his appropriate Global Balance Pattern, and list the acupuncture points that you would select to treat on the Acupuncture Model.
10. Case Study: Male Yin Fire patient with right sided forearm pain between acupuncture points Heart 4 and Small Intestine 7. Please list your acupuncture treatment points, including Global Balance Pattern and local points. Justify your yin surface and yang surface (polarity) choices for Global Balance.
